Dear Messrs. Pacheco and Hughes,

Animal Advocates Alliance would like to express its gratitude for your decision to arrest and charge Glynn Johnson with felony animal cruelty. It is our belief, based on the publicly released facts and witness accounts, that Mr. Johnson did not act in self-defense; rather, his actions were clearly intended to harm a defenseless animal. Accordingly, we respectfully request that your department seek the maximum penalty allowed under CA Penal Code §§ 596-597 of one year imprisonment and a fine of \$20,000.

It is our sincere hope that your department will continue to aggressively pursue all cases of animal cruelty in Riverside County, including those which have received less media exposure. It is also our hope that we can be of assistance to you in prosecuting these crimes. The Board of Directors of Animal Advocates Alliance currently consists of four attorneys (including two litigators), all of whom are willing and able to assist your department in any way possible.
